Among the blind in Singapore, 40 per cent suffer visual loss because of glaucoma. Despite being so widespread, glaucoma is still identified late as it doesn't have obvious symptoms such as pain, eye redness, blurring of vision, double vision or tearing. Discernible visual impairment only occurs when it is very advanced – which is why it is also called 'Silent Thief of Sight'.
